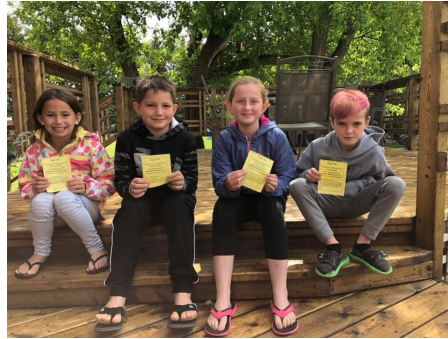

E-Alert:

Administration is working on a system that will notify ratepayers (via email) of critical and severe information that has an affect on or within our Municipality. Examples include fire bans, water breaks, service disruptions, any issues relating to safety or have the potential to pose life threatening situations.

Garbage Pickup:

To help our community save a few dollars annually and encourage residents to start recycling, we are hoping to have garbage picked up every second week in the winter months.

This would make garbage pick up happen on the following dates:

October 31, November 14, November 28, December 12, December 19

(none December 26 and January 2 due to Christmas Holidays),

January 9, January 23, February 6, February 20, March 5.

We would then continue with weekly pickups in March.

The Municipality is looking into what the best recycling option is for our entire municipality and we will make sure to keep residents posted with any and all updates.
